On Saturday, Brown and Howlett put Leeds 2-0 ahead inside the first 20 minutes, although the Raiders had hauled themselves level just under two minutes into the third period through strikes from Jake Sylvester and Riley MacRae.

Adkins quickly restored the Knights' lead at 43.57, only for MacRae's second to level things up again within a minute.

Only 31 more seconds had elapsed before Matt Haywood put the visitors ahead again, but that man MacRae was determined to spoil the night for Leeds when he sealed a deserved hat-trick in the 55th minute.

A second for Haywood, however, with 56.40 on the clock, proved a goal too far for the hosts, Brown sealing both points when he fired home for a 6-4 win with just 18 seconds remaining.
